- Call to Order.
- Councilman Weiner called the meeting to order.
- Councilman Weiner advised that due to a lack of a quorum minutes were not approved or required.
- People attending the meeting are identified as followed Mike Kozikowski Recorder Of Deeds, Daniel Scherquist from the executive office, Lou Hinkle legislative aide to Councilman Weiner, Councilman Robert Weiner, Tonney Gardner chief of administrative services, Anthony deFiore , legislative aide to Council President Bullock, Angeliqne Maravelias legislative aide to Tim Sheldon, Fabrice duBeck and Jim Boyle.
- Councilman Weiner introduced Tonney Gardner chief of administrative services for New Castle County who provided an overview of administrative services. Mr. Gardner provided a brief overview of the process for obtaining a request for procurement.
- Councilman Weiner introduced Daniel Scherquist who provided additional information for the procurement process.
- Councilman Weiner discussed the subject of posting information to the New Castle County Council website.
- Councilman Weiner asked Jim Boyle when County Council approved the three members of Council who have access to make changes to the Internet. Boyle responded that it was done in a meeting without the benefit of legislation and had occurred sometime approximately 9 years ago. Boyle advised that the subject was discussed at an executive committee meeting and went up for a vote.
